






Orientation Policy

Inclusion

- Increase in the number of students in general education for 80% or more of their school day
- Decrease in students starting Kindergarten in center-based programming
- Increase in Kindergarten students that maintain or increase general education time throughout the school year

Non-Exclusionary Discipline

- Decrease out of school suspensions for students on IEPs

Student Outcomes

- Increase in progress report outcomes
- Increase in four-year grad rate for students on IEPs

High Quality Staffing

- Increase retention of high performing special education staff
